# HOPE

Eighteen years ago our family's life changed in a violent, grotesque instant. My daughter Leslie told me she'd been raped three months prior. I couldn't believe what I was hearing. Our family was close-knit... we were happy... we were good people. How could something like this happen to us?

This brutal act of violence against my child was the start of pain and suffering that lasted for years. Like most survivors of rape, my little girl suffered from Rape Trauma Syndrome and I couldn't help her.

When Leslie started running away, the local authorities would find her and bring her home only to run away again. When Leslie turned to crime, it was – strangely – a blessing. A parent never wishes that their child be arrested and charged, but we were so thankful that our child was. Behind bars, Leslie was safer than she was on the streets, and the caseworkers, probation officers and judges were all very helpful.



Many people avoid “the system” at all costs. For us, it was a godsend because “the system” placed Leslie at Jackson-Feild.

The treatment services and family services were a true blessing, and our little girl's healing process began at Jackson-Feild.

# HEAL

## Program

Jackson-Feild Behavioral Health Services (JFBHS) provides high-quality residential treatment services for boys and girls ages 11 to 21 who have mental illness, personality disorders and have suffered severe emotional trauma.

## Educational Services

Our on-campus Gwaltney School provides regular and special education instruction of core subjects as well as electives, vocational education with certifications, GED preparation, distance learning, college courses and specialized web-based courses. Each student has their own customized educational plan.

## Residential Services

When residents are not in school or receiving therapeutic services they participate in a wide range of services that include psycho-educational classes, recreation, spiritual and expressive arts services.

## Addiction and Recovery Treatment

Our substance use treatment services are for children who have a primary diagnosis of substance use and are suffering from the result of their addictions. Our staff of licensed and credentialed addiction specialists help facilitate healing and recovery.
